The Case was that of **Dr Hawley Harvey Crippen**, for the murder of his second wife, **Mrs Cora Crippen** (*nee* Turner). It was investigated by the famous pathologist Bernard Spilsbury (it was actually his first case). The radio was used by the captain of the SS Montrose [on which Crippen and his mistress (disguised as a boy) were sailing to Canada] to Chief Inspector Drew in London, who boarded the faster SS Laurentic, and arrested the pair on **31 July 1910**.
